Members of the genus Lilium produce a chemical, present throughout the plant that is toxic, particularily to cats and results in

kidney failure and often death. It can be deadly for a cat to bite into a leaf or flower, or even lick the water from the vase that the cut flowers are in Symptoms of toxicity include vomiting, lethargy or loss of appetite.

If you suspect this is the case, immediate medical treatment will make the difference between life and death.
